Combining distance riding with trail ability, STC events offer a little of everything to the trail-riding enthusiast. The goal at each ride is to test trail ability of horse/rider teams and reward top competitors.

STC Offers: One day competitive rides with (3) different distances, speeds and levels of difficulty. Horse/Rider teams start with (0) and earn performance points throughout the ride.

General Information: **Come prepared to have fun.** Check in on Friday afternoon or Saturday morning ready to enjoy an outing with friendly, horse-loving people in some of Texas' most beautiful scenery. Saturday morning arrivals, please be at Valley View by 7:00AM for check in. Ride out is 9 am. **Negative Coggin's test required.** (Original form only)

Dogs are allowed in camp and must be kept on leash or otherwise confined at all times. Horses may be tied to your trailer, confined in portable pens, or stabled in any safe manner. You may use any kind of tack, but it must include some form of a bridle and saddle. Any kind of hoof and leg protection is allowed.

Divisions: **Level 1** teams ride 10/15 miles at 3-4 mph with simple obstacles. **Level 2** distance is 20/25 miles at 4-5 mph with more challenging obstacles. **Level 3** distance is 25/30 miles at 5-6 mph with advanced obstacles. **Junior classes for riders age 17 and under are offered in each division. A Junior rider, under age 10, must be accompanied by an adult competitor on trail.** Juniors are required to wear helmets when mounted and must ride mares or geldings

Judges: Each event has at least (4) experienced CTR judges who have met specific requirements as required by the STC judging program.

Awards: The six highest scoring teams in each class will receive awards. The title of Supreme Trail Champion and a special award will go to the highest scoring team. Completion awards for all finishers.

Camp: Valley View is on FM 2777 at LBJ Grasslands North of Decatur, Texas. There are restrooms, windmill for horse water, parking spurs, fire rings and a group pavilion. Generators are allowed.

Camping fee: Five dollars per night per rig. Rigs may arrive as early as Thursday.
